

**UPDATE ON CURRENT CANCER SERVICES /  
COVID-19 PROCEDURES FOR PROTECTING PATIENTS AND STAFF**

• **Introducing Patients Back into Facilities**

- **Bone Marrow Aspirations/Biopsies** are being scheduled and performed.
- **Infusions/Injections/Port Flushes** all back in clinics.
- **New Cancer** patient referrals are being seen in the office and are able to bring one family member/caregiver with them.
- **New Hematology** referrals are being seen via Telemedicine.
- **Follow Up visits** will continue via *Telemedicine*.
- **Suspicion of Cancer Patients and Radiation Referrals** are being seen in the office.
- **Patient tests and/or procedures** are being scheduled.
- Physicians are making Hospital visits.
- **Nasopharyngeal Scopes** are being scheduled.
- All **Radiation Patients** undergoing treatment are being treated.

• **We will continue to do the following:**

- Outside Screening with temperature and questionnaire
- All patients must wear a mask when entering the facility. If the patient does not have a mask, one will be provided.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the screening table and all patients are to use prior to entering facilities.
- Social Distancing will be encouraged and practiced within our facilities to the best of our ability.
- All staff will continue to wear and use appropriate PPE and perform frequent hand washing and/or use of hand sanitizer.
- Visitors will continue to be restricted and will not be allowed into the building.
- Volunteers will return to the facilities after January 11, 2021.
