Introducing Patients Back into Facilities

- Bone Marrow Aspirations/Biopsies are being scheduled and performed.
- Infusions/Injections/Port Flushes all back in clinics.
- New Cancer patient referrals are being seen in the office and are able to bring one family member/caregiver with them.
- New Hematology referrals are being seen via Telemedicine.
- o **Follow Up visits** will continue via *Telemedicine*.
- Suspicion of Cancer Patients and Radiation Referrals are being seen in the office.
- Patient tests and/or procedures are being scheduled.
- Physicians are making Hospital visits.
- Nasopharyngeal Scopes are being scheduled.
- All Radiation Patients undergoing treatment are being treated.

We will continue to do the following:

- Outside Screening with temperature and questionnaire
- All patients must wear a mask when entering the facility. If the patient does not have a mask, one will be provided.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the screening table and all patients are to use prior to entering facilities.
- Social Distancing will be encouraged and practiced within our facilities to the best of our ability.
- All staff will continue to wear and use appropriate PPE and perform frequent hand washing and/or use of hand sanitizer.
- o Visitors will continue to be restricted and will not be allowed into the building.
- o Volunteers will return to the facilities after January 11, 2021.
